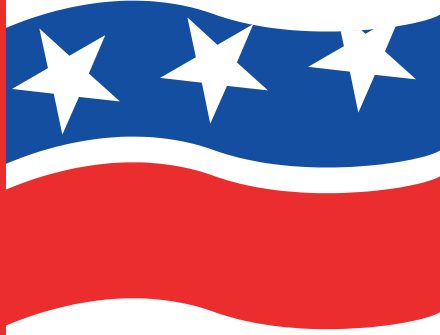

The Second Annual *We the People* Chicago Metro Summer Institute

The Summer Institute is a three-day professional development program to prepare participants to teach in-depth lessons on the U.S. Constitution. Up to 24 Illinois teachers from all grade levels can apply.

Lecture, Teaching Method and Assessment of Content address the following issues:

- ★ How have the protections of the Bill of Rights been developed and expanded?
- ★ What Rights do the Bill of Rights protect?

The three days will include:

- ★ Classes: A leading Constitutional Scholar (Dr. Richard Hardy) lectures and leads discussions on aspects of the U.S. Constitution
- ★ Lesson Demonstrations: Elementary, middle and high school teachers demonstrate *We the People...* curriculum, and serve as mentors to assist and advise participants.
- ★ The Simulated Congressional Hearing will be the culminating activity of the institute.
- ★ Academic credit from North Park University will be available and CPDU's.
- ★ Breakfast and lunch will be included each day.

"We the People...the Citizen and the Constitution" is a nationally acclaimed program that helps students understand the history and principles of our constitutional government. It provides teachers with important resources such as textbooks, lesson plans, and numerous professional development opportunities. The program focuses on the U.S. Constitution and the Bill of Rights, and fosters civic competence and responsibility among elementary, middle, and secondary school students in public and private schools. The program is funded by the United States Department of Education by act of Congress, and is administered nationally by the Center for Civic Education (www.civiced.org). Several studies by the Educational Testing Service (ETS) indicate that students who used the curriculum "significantly outperformed comparison students" on every topic studied.
